TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

Cambridge International General Certificate of Education **Advanced (A) Level** has passing grades from A* - E and from A - E for Advanced Subsidiary (AS) Levels. The grade A* indicates the highest level of achievement and E indicates the minimum required performance. U is Ungraded for both qualifications.

The **Percentage Uniform Mark** in the Statement of Results should be used by higher education institutions in India for admission purposes. As the name suggests, percentage uniform mark is always calculated out of 100. Conversion of grades to marks is applicable only for candidates from countries where Cambridge International Examinations does not provide percentage uniform marks. The date of birth of the candidate is recorded in the Statement of Results.

Provisional Statement of Results

Provisional Statement of Results (transcript) of all Cambridge examinations are released electronically on the same day throughout the world.

2018 March exam series : Results release on 17 May 2018
2018 June exam series : Results release by 15 August 2018
2018 November exam series : Results release by 10 Jan 2019

Result Documents

Cambridge does not issue 'Passing Certificate' to students. The certificate awards grades for each subject level qualification. Where a student fails to reach the standard required for a pass in a subject, the Statement of Results will record **Ungraded in the subject.** Explanatory notes are printed on the Statement of Results.

Certificates from Cambridge are despatched within eight weeks after provisional results are released. There is no change in the final Statement of Results unless a student decides to contest the same. The certificates confirm candidates' results in each graded subject as final. Provisional results are accepted worldwide for admission purposes.

If colleges and universities accept students with Cambridge qualifications prior to that date, we recommend that conditional admission is offered on the basis of predicted grades issued by Cambridge schools.

If an institute is dealing with large numbers of Cambridge candidates and would like direct access to the electronic results for those specific candidates, it is possible for Cambridge to grant access to one designated individual. This has reference to your .letter of date seeking clarification on the parity of examinations conducted by Cambridge International Examinations.

In this connection, this is to inform you that AIU has already accorded equivalence fo GCE 'O' & 'A' Level Examinations in terms of the following:

- Minimum five passes at IGCSE/GCSE/GCE "O" Level Examinations, including English, of the approved British Examining Bodies, has been equated with Grade 10 of an Indian Board.
- Minimum 2/3 passes at GCE "Advanced" (A) Level Examination of the approved British Examining Bodies, has been equated with +2 stage qualifications of an Indian Board.
- The subjectwise eligibility shall be decided by the Admission giving University as per their existing Rules & in case of Professional Examinations, as per the conditions laid down by the respective Councils.
- Student intending to join Medical Programmes are required to have studied the subjects of English at 'AS' Level.
